Fast Tarp Shelter

Sometimes you need to set up a tarp very quickly. For example, you might get caught in an unexpected rain shower. Or perhaps you are on a hike, and you would like to have protection from sun or wind while you prepare and eat lunch. Here is one of the quickest ways to set up a simple tarp shelter. It only takes a few minutes.

- 1. For you first step, spread your tarp on the ground in a diamond shape, with one corner pointing towards a tree. Tie one end of your paracord to that tarp corner using a taut line hitch.
- 2. Tie the other end to the tree trunk as high up as you can reach. Use another taut line hitch.
- 3. Stake the tarp corner farthest from the tree to the ground. Then stake the remaining two corners and side gromets.
- 4. To give yourself more headroom, use a hiking stick as pillar inside.
